Note:

- Only facilities for which reservations may be obtained in the Naches Ranger District are **campgrounds contracted out to the Northwest Land Management concessionaire. Including the five group sites (no discount when reserving group sites).**
 - When requesting reservations, specify CAMP NAME and NATIONAL FOREST NAME, as many facilities have the same name but are located in different places. Arrival and departure dates, type of site required (tent, RV, cabin, lookout, etc.), your address and phone number, method of payment, VISA, MasterCard, AMEX and Discover accepted.
 - Family campsites may be reserved 240 days ahead of the day of arrival. Group campsites may be reserved 360 days ahead.
 - A reservation fee of \$10.00 in addition to the camping fee will be charged and all nights booked must be paid for at the time of making reservation.
 - You may cancel and receive a full refund less reservation fee and cancellation fee. You will also pay a penalty equal to first night's reservation if you cancel 13 days or less in advance of use.

If you have either a Golden Age or Golden Access Passport, they provide you with a 50% discount on the recreation use fee for individual campsites. This discount does not apply to fees for Alaska cabins or group facilities. Customers that have one of these passports are required to provide the passport number at the time the reservation is made to receive the discount. If the customer makes more than one reservation for the same location and date(s), the discount will only apply to the site the passport holder occupies. Customers using one of these passports are required to present the passport and one form of identification to confirm the discount upon arrival at the site. If you do not provide proper documentation, you must pay the full recreation use fee prior to using the facility.
