- **Activity Booths:** Specify the activity and requirements needed. For example, a speed pitching booth might only need a booth 10' wide, but might require a 20+' length.
- **Additional Food Vendor Requirements:**
  - Washington State Health Card, \$10
  - Health Permit from the Yakima County Health District, \$54 (1210 Ahtanum Rd/509-575-4040) **Permit required 1 week prior to the event.**
  - Vendors can sell food products of their choice as long as it is listed on your application (drugs and alcohol prohibited).
  - Below is a list of food products sold by priority Naches organizations at Sportsman's Days:

- **Set-up:** All booths/activities must be in place by 4:00 PM Friday. Set up allowed Thursday 4pm-9pm, and Friday 9am-2pm.
- **Start-up:** All Vendors/Activity booths are responsible for providing price points for goods/services and start-up money prior to set-up. Booths must remain open the entire run of the event; Friday 5pm to 10pm; Saturday 11am to 9pm.
- **Security:** On site security is provided Friday Night (9/8/23) only.
- **Tear Down:** Vendors must be out by 9:00 AM Sunday.
- **Parking:** Vehicles prohibited on Sportsman's Days grounds Friday 4pm through Sunday 6am. Vendors will be required to park their vehicles in designated areas ONLY and to display a dashboard pass per vehicle provided by the Lions Club.
- **Electricity:** Vendors must provide their own power cords, power strips, lights, etc. The Naches Lions will attempt to supply 110V electricity and one plug-in receptacle to each space for lights. Electrical usage limited to a 20 amp service. Additional fees may apply if more plug-ins or higher amp service are required. Vendors will be disconnected if electrical usage blows fuses or trips breaker. Portable generators that meet the Yakima County noise limitation standards are encouraged for motorhomes.
- **Water:** Potable water station provided. Vendors must provide their own potable water containers for transporting water. Pressurized water is not available for filling food trucks.
- **Responsibility & Safety:**
  - Each vendor is responsible to keep their area clean and safe. Garbage cans and a gray water disposal container are provided by the Naches Lions Club.
  - Gray water waste must be disposed of properly in the gray water disposal container provided by the Lions Club.
  - All booths must be weight secured.
